

TOWER PARK CARAVANS AND CAMPING - Site Rules and Information.

Welcome to Tower Park, and to enable everyone to enjoy their holiday please observe these simple rules.

PARENTS. Please ensure you know where your children and teenagers are, you will be responsible for your children's behaviour and they must be supervised particularly in the play area and toilets. In respect of other campers we expect children to be quietly back at your pitch by 10pm.

NOISE should be kept to a minimum. Radios, televisions, instruments etc be kept at a low volume and we expect the site to be quiet between 10pm and 8am. Generators are not permitted on site.

THE SPEED LIMIT across the site is 5mph. Please drive over the speed bumps and not around them. **THE SECURITY BARRIER** will be closed each night between 11pm and 7am, please park in the late arrivals field and walk to your pitch if returning late at night.

DOGS must be kept on a short lead at all times around the site except in the dog exercise field. They are not allowed in the play area and must not be left unattended. Accidents should be cleaned up immediately and bags disposed of in the green rubbish bins.

DEPARTURE. Please vacate pitches by 12 noon and static caravans by 10am on the day of departure to allow us to clean and cut the grass.

There is an emergency **TELEPHONE** on the site outside the camp shop (999 calls only.) The nearest public telephone box is in the village.

RECEPTION. Please check in at reception on arrival. If you have visitors on site please ask them to park in the late arrivals field by the main gate and report to reception.

TAKE-AWAY. A small cafe/take-away is available in high season for hot and cold drinks, breakfasts and evening meals. Please check with reception for opening times. A fish and chip van visits the site twice a week during peak times.

TOURIST INFORMATION AND TELEPHONE NUMBERS for the local doctor's surgery, the vets and other information can be found on the notice boards in the laundrette. There is also a freezer for **freezer packs**.

You are welcome to **BARBECUE**. Please raise off the grass, we usually have spare barbecues and blocks by the washing up area. Sorry, no Chinese lanterns due to safety and environmental concerns.

THE VILLAGE shop and Post Office is well stocked and open Monday to Saturday 7.30am until 7.30pm and Sunday 8am until 12.00. There is also a garage and petrol station with a good shop open seven days a week. There is a regular bus service with timetables available at site reception.

The **ST BURYAN INN** serves food lunchtimes and evenings and also offers a takeaway service.

RECYCLING . Containers for glass, cans, plastic, paper and cardboard are located around the site next to the big green rubbish bins. Please take care to separate your rubbish and recyclables and place them in the correct container. **No tents, gazebos or furniture etc in the bins please.**

Your admission to the site assumes that you agree to abide by these rules. We reserve the right to terminate any holiday or request any person(s) to leave for a breach of site guidelines. In these circumstances the holiday ceases and we shall not be liable for any extra costs incurred by you.
